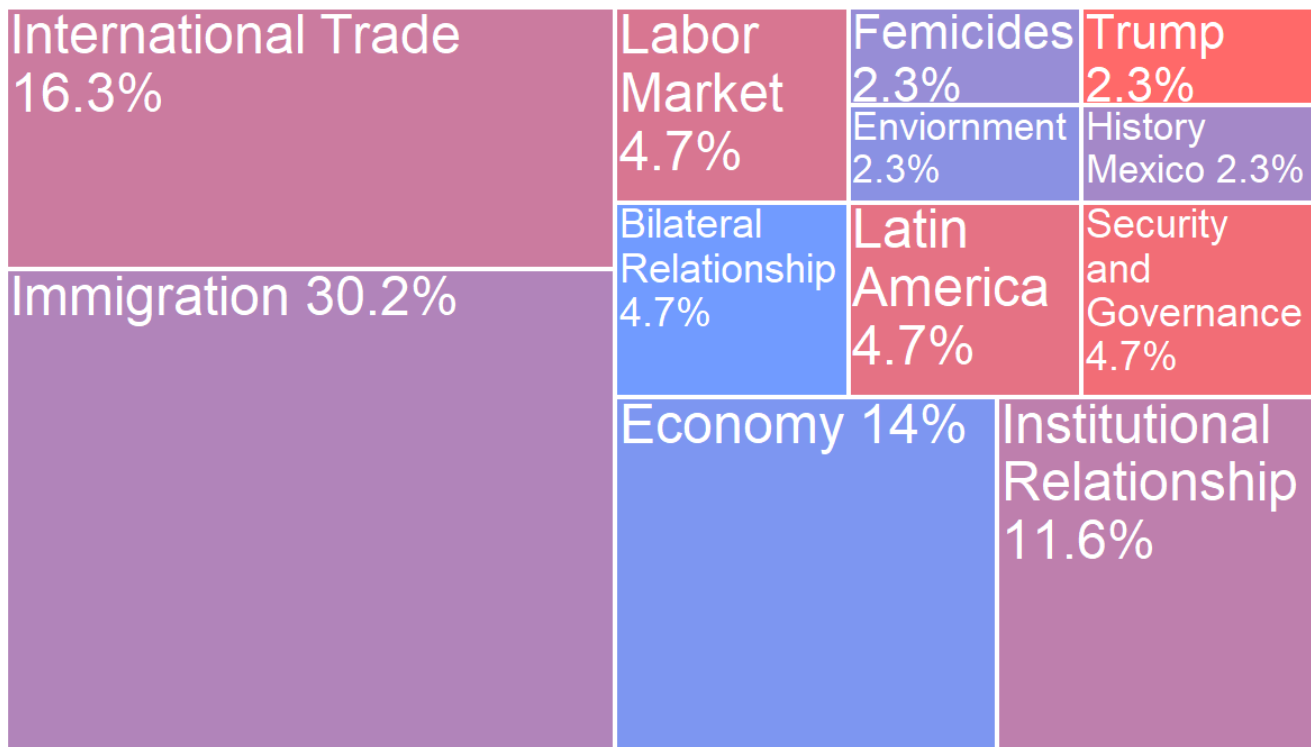
# Coverage Report

September 14<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> of 2021

During the period, 43 articles related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 21 of the articles were published by think tanks in Mexico, while 22 articles were published by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales* (COMEXI) was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 19 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute and the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) with 7 and 3 publications respectively.

During the period, four main topics were discussed, the most mentioned topic was: **Immigration**, regarding the United States-Mexico border crisis. Followed by: **International Trade**, **Economics**, and **Institutional Relationship**. Additionally, the topics of: **Labor Market**, **Latin America**, **Bilateral Relations and Security and Governance** were discussed. Finally: **Environment**, **Femicides**, **Mexican history** and **Trump** were mentioned.
