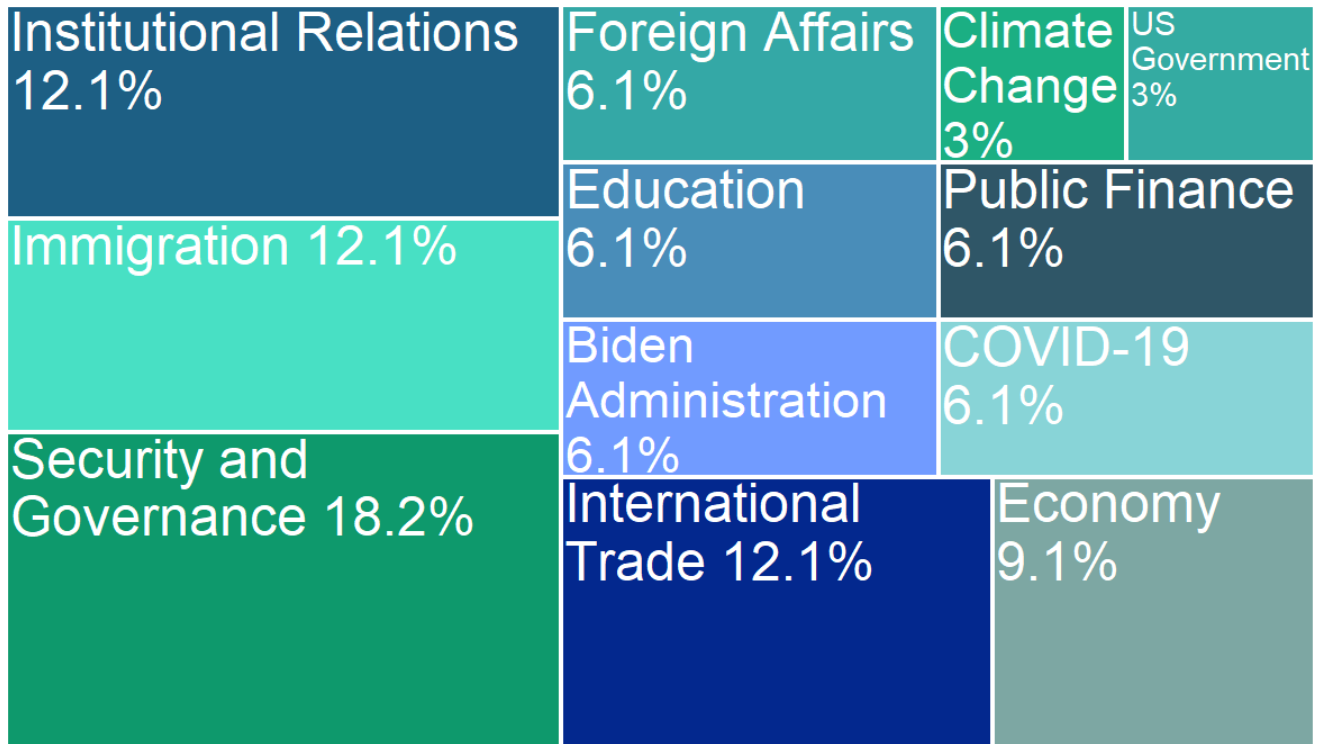
Coverage Report

October 1st to 14th of 2021

During the period, 33 articles related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 22 of the articles were published by think tanks in Mexico, while 11 articles were published by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales* (COMEXI) was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 19 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute and the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) with 4 and 3 publications respectively.

During the period, four main topics were discussed, the most mentioned topic was: **Security and Governance**. Followed by: **International Trade**, **Institutional Relationship** and **Immigration**. Additionally, **Economy**, **Biden Administration**, **Foreign Affairs**, **Education** and **Public Finance** were topics discussed. Finally: **Climate change and the US Government** were mentioned.
