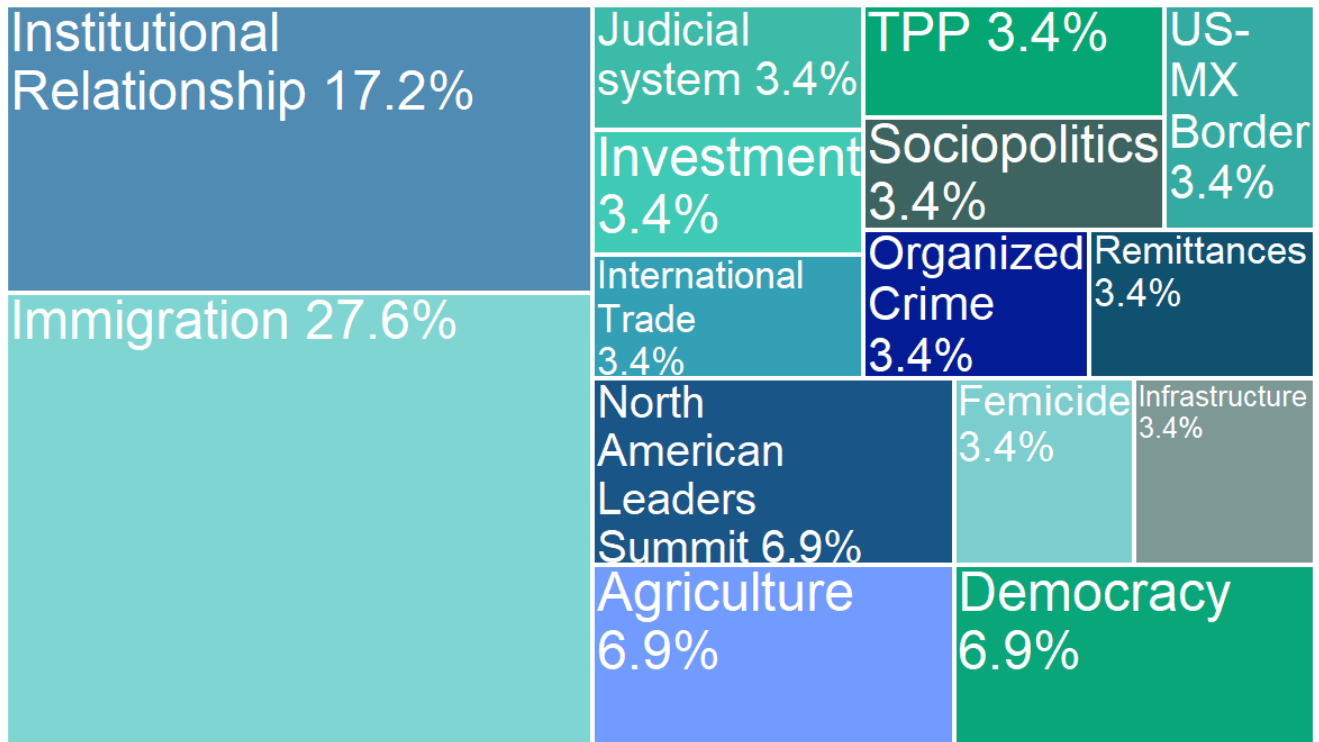
Coverage Report

December 1st to 15th of 2021

During the period, 29 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 18 of the publications were made by think tanks in Mexico, while 11 publications were made by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales (COMEXI)* was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 15 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute and the Baker Institute with 4 publications each, followed by the *Instituto Mexicano para la Competitividad (IMCO)* with 2 publications.

Two main topics were discussed: **Immigration** and the **Institutional relationship** between Mexico and the United States. Followed by **agriculture, democracy**, and the **North American Leaders Summit**. Additionally, the topics of **international trade, investment, organized crime, femicides, the Mexico-United States border, infrastructure**, and **remittances**, among others, were discussed.
