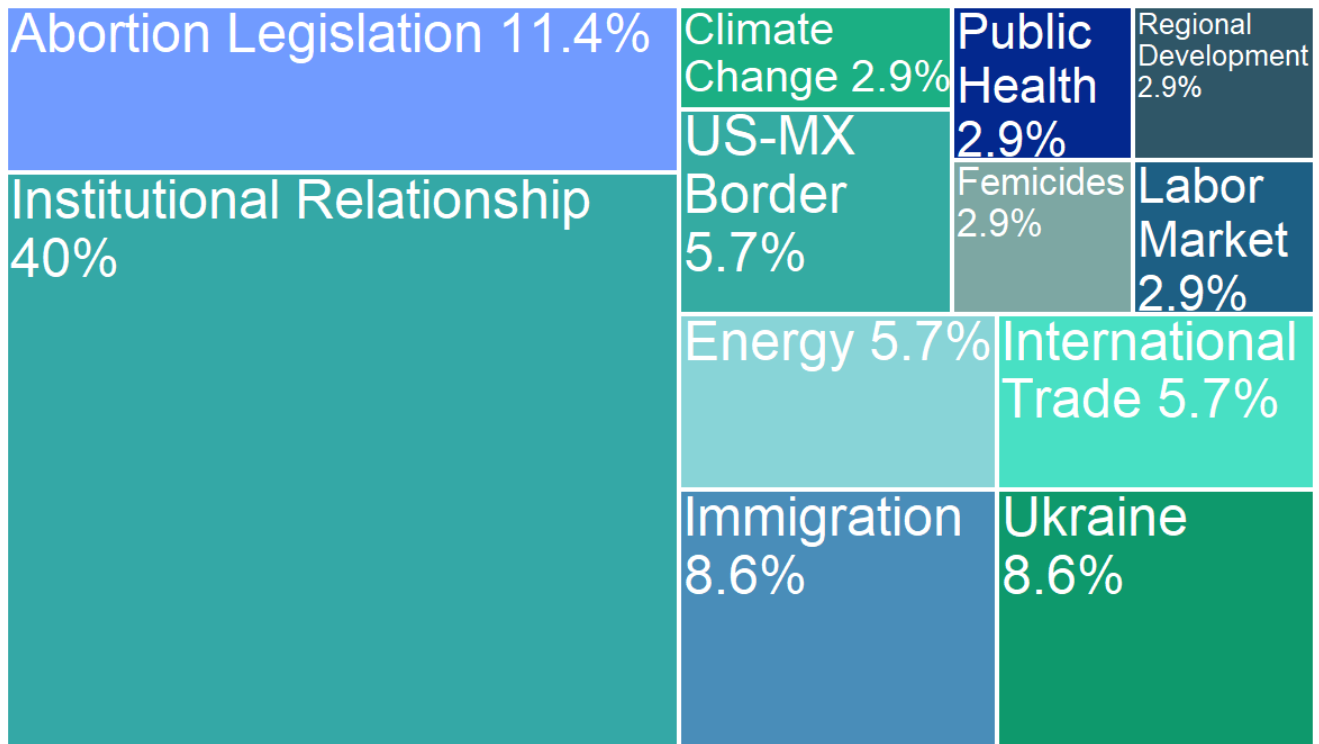
Coverage Report

April 19th to May 15th 2022

During the period, 35 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 19 of the total publications were made by Mexican think tanks, while 18 publications were made by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales (COMEXI)* was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 19 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute with 6 publications, and the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) and the Council on Foreign Affairs with 3 publications each.

The main topic was the **Institutional relationship**, focusing on President Andrés Manuel López Obrador announcement to skip the **Summit of the Americas** and its effect on the bilateral relationship between United States and Mexico, the Summit will be held in June of this year in the city of Los Angeles, California. Followed by the **abortion legislation** in the Supreme Court of Justice. The **Ukraine invasion** and **immigration** between Mexico and the United States were also main topics during the period. Topics such as **international trade**, **energy**, the **electricity reform**, and **organized crime** in the **US-MX border** were also among the publications. Finally other topics discussed include **climate change**, **public health**, the **labor market**, **regional development** and ongoing **femicides** in Mexico.
