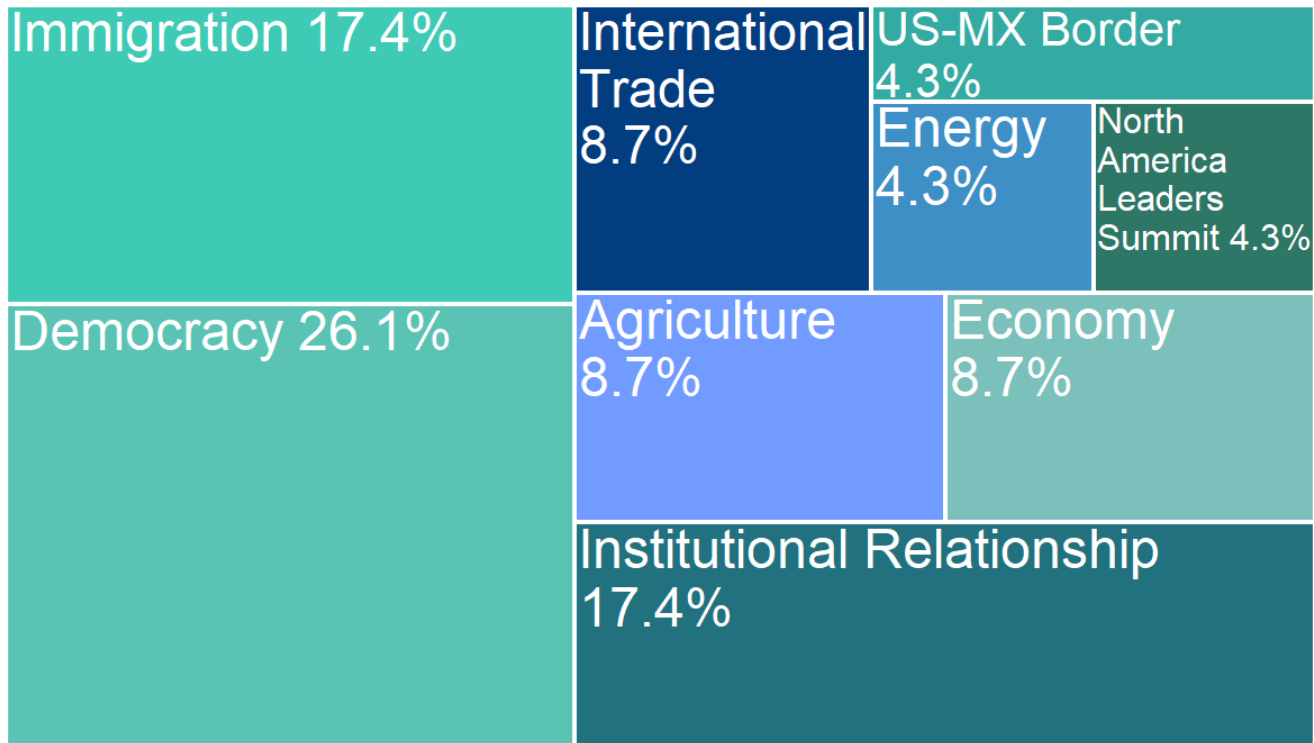
# Coverage Report

December 16<sup>th</sup> 2021 to January 13<sup>th</sup> 2022

During the period, 23 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 13 of the publications were made by think tanks in Mexico, while 10 publications were made by United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales (COMEXI)* was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 12 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute and the Baker Institute with 4 publications and 2 publications respectively.

Three main topics were discussed during the period. The most mentioned was **democracy**, in relation to the United States government and the US capitol attack of 2021, followed by **immigration** and **institutional relationship**. The topics of **agriculture**, **international trade** and **economy** were also mentioned. Finally, **energy**, the **North America Leaders summit** and the **US-Mexico border** were also discussed.
