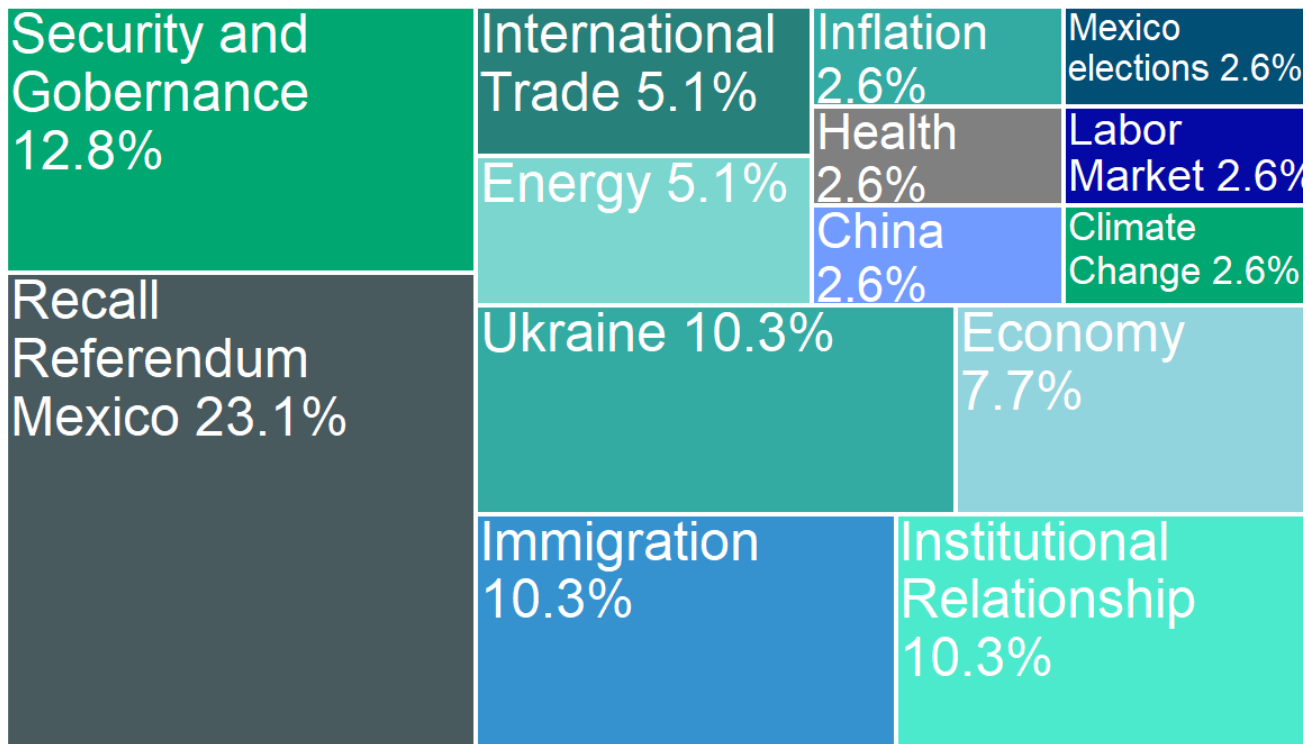
Coverage Report

March 16th to April 18th 2022

During the period, 39 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 2 of the publications were made by think tanks in Mexico, while 37 publications were made by United States think tanks. The Mexico Institute was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 21 publications, followed by the Baker Institute, Brookings and the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) with 3 publications each, and the American Enterprise Institute (AEI) and the *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales (COMEXI)* with 2 publications each.

The main topic was the **recall referendum in Mexico**, followed by **security and governance**, discussing topics such as violence against journalists, drugs, armed forces and illicit trade and trafficking of wildlife in Mexico and its relationship with China. The **Ukraine invasion**, **immigration** and the **institutional relationship** between Mexico and the United States were also main topics during the period. Topics such as the **economy**, investment in Mexico and rising prices, as well as **international trade** and **energy** were among the publications. Finally, the topics of **climate change**, **health**, the **labor market**, the **gubernatorial elections** in Mexico later this year and **China**, among others, were discussed.
