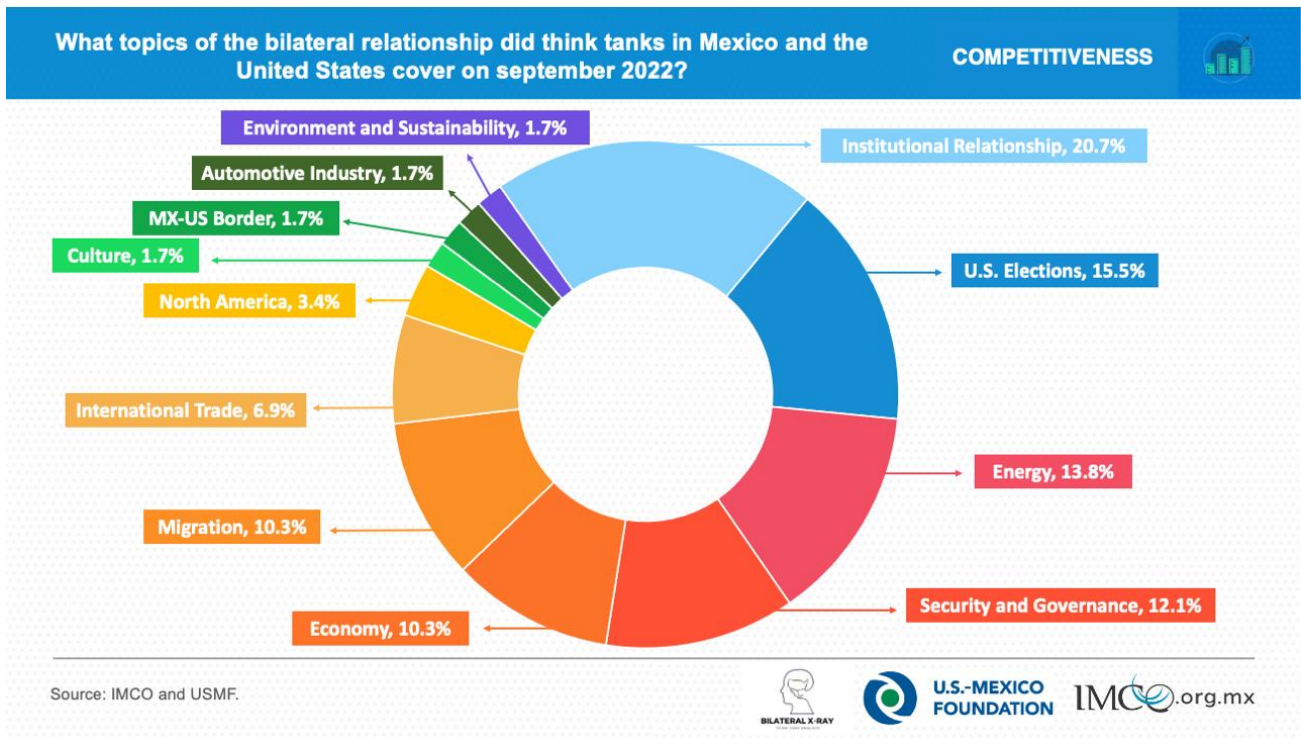
# Coverage Report

September 1<sup>st</sup> to September 30<sup>th</sup> 2022

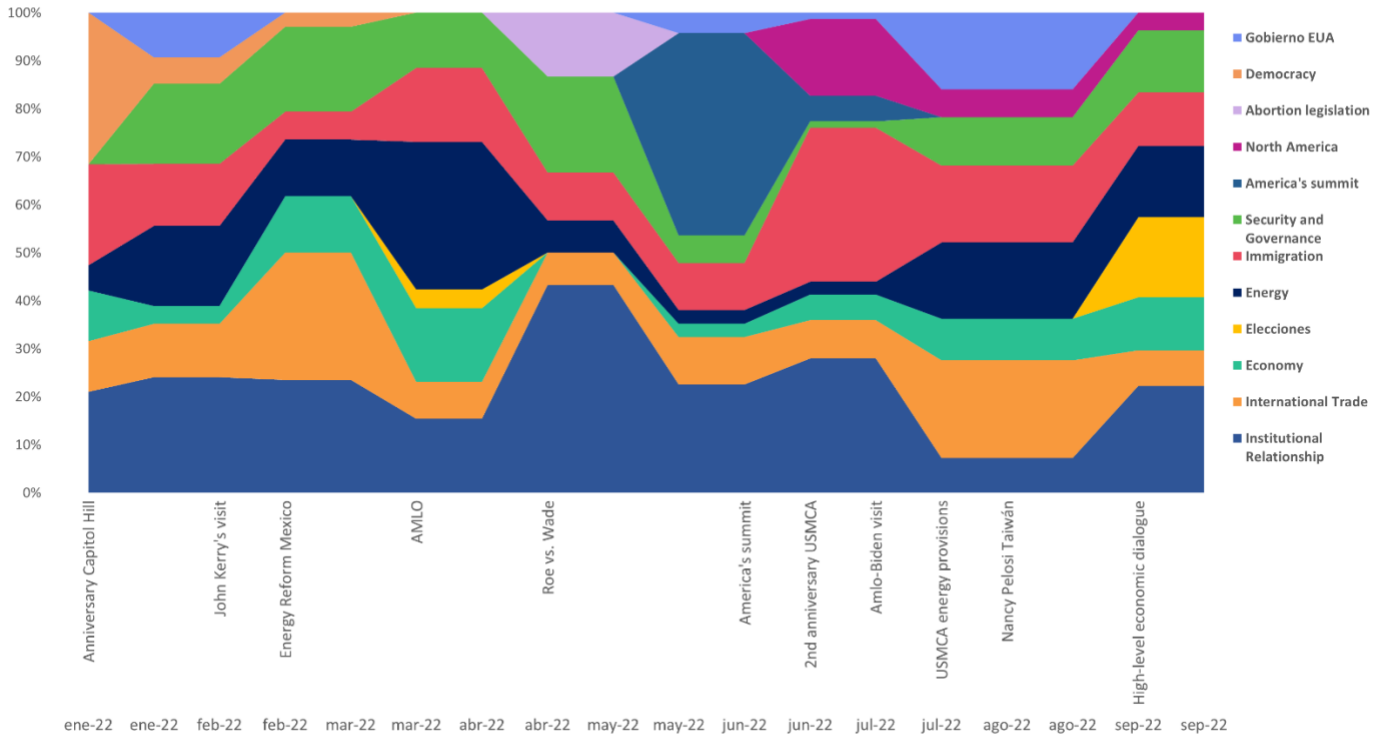
We compiled fifty-eight publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States during the period. Thirty-eight of the total publications were made by Mexican think tanks, while twenty publications were produced by the United States think tanks. The *Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales* (COMEXI) was the leading institution with thirty-two publications, followed by Brookings and the Mexico Institute with four publications each, and *México Evalúa* and the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) with three publications each.

The main topic was institutional relations, focusing mainly on the 200 years of the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States and diplomacy. Second, the upcoming midterm elections in the U.S. featured the growing polarization in the country, where immigration and abortion issues were on the main agenda—followed by energy focusing on Mexico's energy policy and the USMCA provisions. Fourth, and given the High-Level Economic Dialogue was held in Mexico in mid-September, the economy was also a recurrent topic. Competitiveness and supply chains for North America were among the issues published. We also saw immigration, security, and governance militarization due to organized crime and Mexico's security strategy. Also, think tanks discussed international trade, the idea of North America, culture, the U.S.-Mexico border, the automotive industry, the environment, and sustainability.
