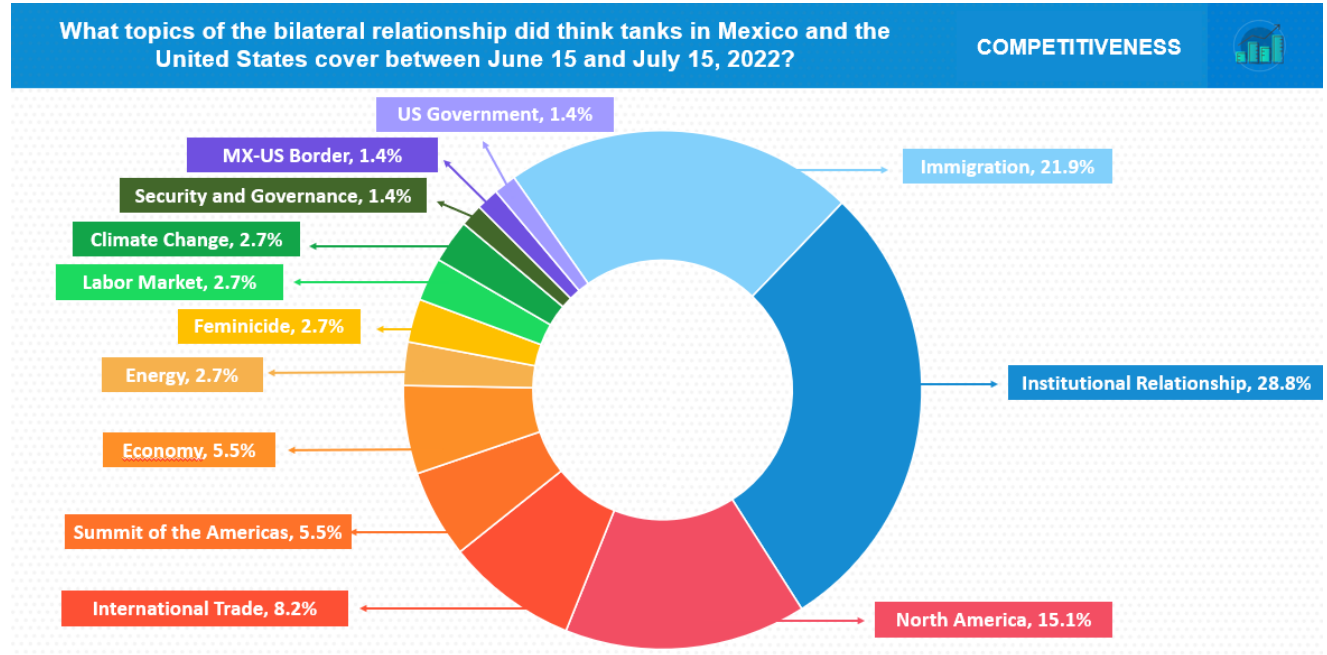
Coverage Report

June 15th to July 15th 2022

During the period, 73 publications related to the bilateral relationship between Mexico and the United States were compiled. 37 of the total publications were made by Mexican think tanks, while 36 publications were made by United States think tanks. The Consejo Mexicano de Asuntos Internacionales (COMEXI) was the center with the most publications related to the bilateral relationship with 28 publications, followed by the Mexico Institute with 24 publications and the Instituto Mexicano para la competitividad (IMCO) with 7 publications.

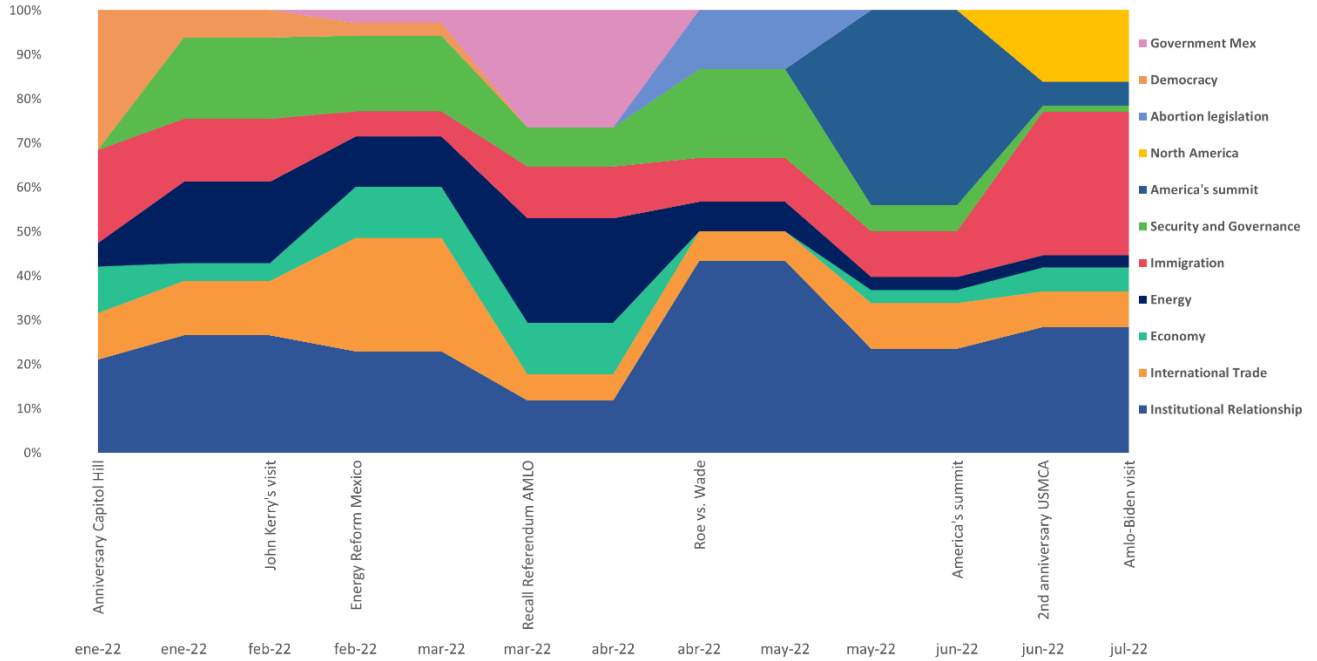
The main topic was institutional relationship, focusing mainly on President Andrés Manuel López Obrador visit to Washington D.C. where he had meetings with President Joe Biden and Vice President Kamala Harris. Followed by immigration, where labor opportunities, remittances in historical numbers, the migrant crisis at the border and the "Remain in Mexico" policy were addressed. Followed by the topic of North America and international trade, since it was the 2nd year anniversary of the USMCA. Topics such as economy and inflationary pressures, the Summit of the Americas, climate change, energy, femicides in Mexico and the labor market were also addressed. Finally other topics discussed include the US government, the US-Mexico border, as well as security and governance.

The chart above shows the most popular subjects for each month. Among the topics that constantly appear are international trade, institutional relation, energy, economy, security and governance, and migration. On the other hand, short-term events usually generate a greater number of publications, as can be seen with the following topics: North America, the Mexican government, the Summit of the Americas and democracy, these are linked to a specific event.
